The PTA Fun run was a great success! Thank you




Table Tennis

P7 pupils and teachers have been working very hard over the past weeks preparing for their performance of Matilda.




We are all very much looking forward to what will be a very entertaining show. Tickets still available for tonight 16thJune @ 7pm, £4.00.
